



## **ROADWAY REHABILITATION AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS**

Road improvements are being done at the following locations between September and December:

- North California Boulevard between Pringle Avenue and Ygnacio Valley Road
- South California Boulevard between Mt. Diablo Boulevard and Botelho Drive
- Newell Avenue between Maria Lane and Broadway
- Montego between Ygnacio Valley Road and Tampico
- San Luis Road between North Main Street and Larkey Lane

Changeable message signs will be placed at the approaches to each of the work locations to notify traffic of the upcoming work. (A map of project locations is included at the end of this document.)

Project work will include:

### **1. Roadway Rehabilitation on South/North California Boulevard, Newell Avenue, and a portion of San Luis Road east of Casa Way.**

The work will include removing and replacing the top 2.5” of the asphalt roadway and repairing the road where the asphalt is starting to fail. To reduce impacts to traffic and increase worker safety, the paving work will be done between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. The overnight paving work is estimated to take approximately one week to complete at each location.

### **2. Roadway Rehabilitation on Montego and San Luis Road west of Casa Way.**

The work will include removing and replacing the top 2.5” to 2.75” of the asphalt roadway and repairing the roadway areas where the asphalt is starting to fail. The paving work on Montego and San Luis Road will be done between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday through Friday, with lane closure hours restricted to 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. to reduce impacts to the residential neighborhood. The daytime paving work is estimated to take approximately one week to complete at each location.

### **3. Americans with Disabilities Act improvements at curb ramps and miscellaneous concrete repairs.**

Hours for this work will be from Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Portions of the sidewalk will be closed during the construction period. Pedestrians will be directed to take alternative routes until repairs are complete.

The City understands that there will be inconveniences due to the construction and will try to maintain access and minimize any expected lane closures or delays. During construction, “No Parking” signs will be posted in advance of work. Vehicles that are left in posted areas will be towed if necessary at the vehicle owner’s expense.

The work is being paid for by a Federal Grant (the Congestion Management Agency Block Grant for Local Streets and Roads.)
